42" x 58"

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Materials List

Quilt Top

- 3, 1 yard cuts of fabric

Backing Fabric

- 3 yards of fabric

Other Materials

- Twin-size batting
- Thread to match fabric

This is an economy quilt designed to efficiently utilize 44" wide fabric. A single fold binding is used. An additional 1/2 yard of fabric is needed for a double fold binding.

- 1/4" seam allowance throughout
- WOF means Width of Fabric
- HST means Half Square Triangle

Cutting Instructions

From Fabric #1:

* Cut 2, 3½" x WOF for Strip Assembly "A"
* Cut 1, 4" x WOF; from this strip, cut 6, 4" x 4" squares for HST-1

Assembly

* Cut 1, 5½" x WOF; from this strip, cut 12, 3½" x 5½" strips for Unit "C" Assembly

* Cut 5, 3½" x WOF for border #2

From Fabric #2:

* Cut 2, 5½" x WOF for Strip Assembly "A"
* Cut 1, 5½" x WOF for Strip Assembly "B"
* Cut 1, 5½" x WOF; from this strip, cut 1, 5½" x 30" for Partial Strip Assembly "B".

From the remainder of this strip, cut 2, 4" x 4" squares for HST-1 & HST-2 Assembly

* Cut 1, 4" x WOF; from this strip, cut 10, 4" x 4" squares for HST-1 & HST-2 Assembly

* Cut 4, 1½" x WOF for border #1

From Fabric #3:

* Cut 1, 3½" x WOF for Strip Assembly "B"
* Cut 1, 3½" x WOF; from this strip, cut 1, 3½" x 30" for Partial Strip Assembly "B"

* Cut 1, 4" x WOF; from this strip, cut 6, 4" x 4" squares for HST-2

Assembly

* Cut 1, 5½" x WOF; from this strip, cut 12, 3½" x 5½" strips for Unit "D" Assembly

* Cut 5, 1½" x WOF for border #3

* Cut 5, 1¼" x WOF for binding

From Backing Fabric:

* Cut 2, 54" x WOF

Step 1: Unit "A" & "B"

Assembly

Referring to Strip Assembly "A" diagram, using one fabric #1, 3½" x WOF strip and one fabric #2, 5½" x WOF strip, sew together on long edges. Repeat making 2 assemblies. Cut into 12, 5½" x 8½" Unit "A". Referring to Strip Assembly "B" diagram, using one fabric #2, 5½" x WOF strip and one fabric #3, 3½" x WOF strip, sew together on long edges. Repeat using Partial Strip Assembly "B" strips, making one full and one partial assemblies. Cut into 12, 5½" x 8½" Unit "B".

Step 2: HST-1 & HST-2

Assembly

Referring to HST-1 Assembly diagram, using a fabric marking pen, draw a line diagonally from corner to corner on wrong side of fabric #2, 4" x 4" squares. Using one each of fabric #1 and #2, 4" x 4" squares for each HST-1 Assembly, place right sides together. Sew a scant ¼" on each side of line. Cut on drawn line; press blocks open. Trim and square blocks to 3½" x 3½". Repeat making 12, 3½" x 3½" HST-1 Blocks.

Referring to HST-2 Assembly diagram, repeat using fabric #2 and #3, 4" x 4" squares, making 12, 3½" x 3½" HST-2 Blocks.

Step 3: Unit "C" & "D"

Assembly

Referring to Unit "C" Assembly diagram, using one HST-1 Block and one fabric #1, 3½" x 5½" strip, sew together as shown. Repeat making 12, 3½" x 8½" Unit "C". Referring to Unit "D" Assembly diagram, using one HST-2 Block and one fabric #3, 3½" x 5½" strip, sew together as shown. Repeat making 12, 3½" x 8½" Unit "D".

Step 4: Block "A" & "B" Assembly

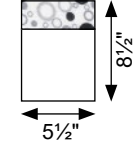
Assembly

Referring to Block "A" Assembly diagram, using one Unit "A" and one Unit "C", sew together as shown. Repeat making 12, 8½" x 8½" Block "A". Referring to Block "B" Assembly diagram, using one Unit "B" and one Unit "D", sew together as shown. Repeat making 12, 8½" x 8½" Block "B".

Strip Assembly "A"



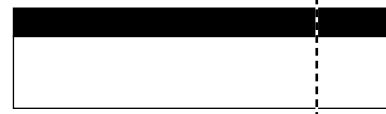

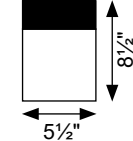
Make 2 assemblies.

Strip Assembly "B"



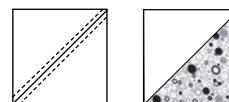
Unit "B"

Cut 12, 5½" x 8½" Unit "B"

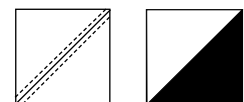
HST-1 Assembly



Draw line from corner to corner. Sew a scant ¼" on each side of line. Cut on drawn line.

Make 12, 3½" x 3½" HST-1 Blocks

HST-2 Assembly



Draw line from corner to corner. Sew a scant ¼" on each side of line. Cut on drawn line.

Make 12, 3½" x 3½" HST-2 Blocks

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Step 5: Quilt Assembly

Referring to **Quilt Assembly** diagram, alternating **Blocks “A”** and **“B”** as shown, assemble 6 rows of 4 blocks each.

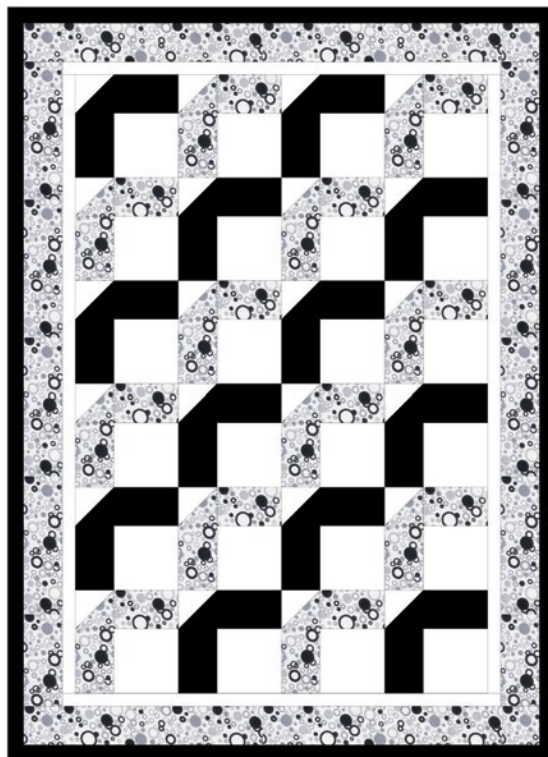
Step 6: Borders

For border #1, using fabric #2, 1½" x WOF border strips, sew together end to end. Sew strip to each side of quilt; trim even with top and bottom. Using remainder of strip, sew to top and bottom; trim even with sides. For border #2, repeat using fabric #1, 3½" x WOF border strips. For border #3, repeat using fabric #3, 1½" x WOF border strips.

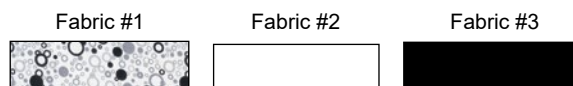
Step 7: Backing & Binding

Sew backing fabric together along trimmed selvage edges; press. Layer top, batting and backing together; quilt as desired. For binding, using fabric #3, 1¼" x WOF strips, sew strips together end to end. Press in half with wrong sides together; press one raw edge to center fold. Place right side of binding to front side of quilt. Using a scant ¼", sew unpressed edge of binding to quilt, mitering corners. Fold to back and hand stitch in place.

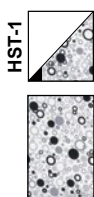

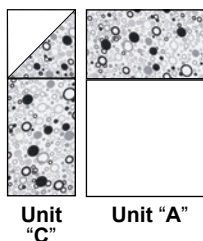


Block “A” Assembly

Unit “C” Assembly

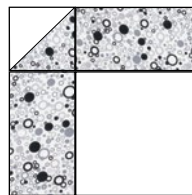


Make 12,

Unit “C”

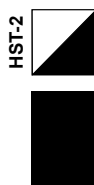


Make 12, 8½" x 8½" Block “A”

Finished Block “A”

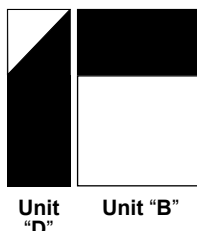


Unit “D” Assembly
